Kresson Road – Browning Lane to Cropwell Road: 6am to 4 pm, Tuesday through Thursday, lane shifts & alternating traffic Springdale to Imperial Drive & Middle Acres to Markkress

Overnight work:

- Lane closures at Kresson Rd & Springdale Rd intersection, 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Monday & 6:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Tuesday
- Local closures & detours, 6:30 pm to 5:30 am, Wednesday night, for paving entrances to all roads off Kresson between Springdale & Cropwell.

Springdale Road, north of Route 70 – Greentree Road to Burlington County Border: Work continues on the northbound side between Greentree Road & Huntington Drive, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. One lane in each direction will remain open.

Evesham Road – Berlin Road to Burnt Mill Road: Construction continues on the southbound, Cherry Hill side near Sussex Avenue 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Lane shifts are in place with one lane maintained in each direction.

Kenilworth Avenue – West Chapel Avenue to Route 38: Full road closure, 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

CCMUA Project:

- **Cooper Landing Road – Valley Run Drive to Route 70** - Crews are scheduled to work overnight Wednesday from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Thursday, & again Friday from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Saturday. There will be alternating traffic.

NJ American Water Project:

- **Cropwell Road – Marlowe Rd to Kresson Rd** - Full road closure. Work is scheduled to resume Monday at 8 p.m. & continue overnight until 5 a.m. Crews are expected to work the remainder of the week (7 p.m. to 5 a.m.) through Friday morning.

NJ Dept. of Transportation Project:

- **Route 70 – NJDOT Construction** - Concrete work continues on the center median between I-295 & Springdale Road.
